OFFSITE VISITS

Safety of the children in our care is our highest priority therefore we always ensure a high staff/child ration and every precaution is taken when children are offsite.

A full risk assessment is carried out before any offsite visit takes place. Permission would always be obtained from parents/carers beforehand. This risk assessment is undertaken to identify the steps to be taken to remove, minimise and manage those risks and hazards.

A first aid kit is always carried and a list of emergency contact numbers.

Each member of staff will be responsible for a specified group of children whilst walking offsite and will continually be aware of their whereabouts during any activity.

Regular head counts will continue throughout the offsite visit.
