SUN SAFETY

As part of our sun safety policy we will:

- *Educate children throughout the curriculum about how to protect them from the sun.
- *Encourage children to wear clothes that provide sun protection such as sunhats.
- *We will make fresh water readily available to all children and ensure they are drinking plenty.
- *In the warm summer months, we spend as much time as possible outdoors. We ask you to apply sun cream to your child before they come into nursery. We also ask that you provide an extra bottle of sun cream so it can be reapplied during the day. These bottles need to be labelled with the child's name on and either left at nursery where possible or kept in their bag. Written permission is also in the welcome pack.
- *Outside play times will be observed and restricted to avoid the hottest sun times.
- *Children must wear hats when playing outdoors.
- *Shelters are available for the children to play under in the hot weather.
- *Encourage staff and parents to act as good role models by practising sun safety.
